

Configuring JSTOR collections in the ProQuest® Summon® Discovery Service: a quick reference guide

JSTOR collections indexed in the Summon Index include the archival journal collections, the Books at JSTOR collections and the current journals in the Current Scholarship Program (CSP). For all these collections, Summon indexes the metadata and article abstracts or book summaries.

To ensure that use of your licensed JSTOR collections is optimized within Summon, you will need to:

 Activate, in your ProQuest Client Center or Intota[™] profile, the JSTOR collections that you license. Review Summon configuration options and search features

For further details on these steps, see below.

Important Note: This guide has been developed to help libraries configure the Summon discovery service to most effectively leverage their investment in content on the JSTOR platform. Our research shows that the appropriate configuration of Summon is an important determinant in the discoverability of the content your library licenses from JSTOR. Further, our research indicates that prioritizing direct links to JSTOR within the Summon administrative module is *the best* way to ensure your users connect reliably to JSTOR. We encourage you to strongly consider reviewing the priority of direct links to JSTOR (described later in the document) so that your library can better leverage its investment in the content it licenses from JSTOR.

Activate the JSTOR collections you license

The JSTOR collections you license must specifically be activated in your ProQuest Client Center or Intota profile. You can also activate other JSTOR collections that you do not license; but if users are directed to non-subscribed items from JSTOR, the user will be presented with a message saying the content is not licensed by their library.

Note that if you are using other ProQuest products, such as the A-to-Z list and

the 360 Link link resolver, you will likely already have activated your subscribed collections. If so, you can skip this section.

If you have not previously configured your JSTOR collections in your ProQuest Client Center Profile, a 1 or 2-step process is needed:

<u>Step 1:</u> In your ProQuest Client Center profile, activate the databases to match the JSTOR collections to which you subscribe.

Step 2: Activate the titles in any JSTOR collection your users do not automatically have access to all titles.

Each of the JSTOR collections contains a title list

- JSTOR archive collections
 - i. As a subscriber to each of the JSTOR collections you have activated in Step 1, your users automatically have access to all titles in each collection and no further action is required.
 - ii. New titles that are added to these collections will automatically be activated.
- Books at JSTOR collections and Current Scholarship Program (CSP) journal collections
 - For these collections you will have to use the Client Center tool ODSE to activate the titles selectively, according to your institutional title holdings.
 - ii. However, if you license the complete collection, once you have activated the collection your users automatically have access to all titles in that collection and no further action is required.
 - iii. If you only subscribe to a few titles in each collection, search for them in your collection's title list in the Client Center and activate them individually. If you subscribe to most, but not all titles, you can add the entire collection and then selectively change those titles to which you do not subscribe to 'Not Tracked'. Alternatively, you can activate titles based on a file you prepare of subscribed titles.

iv. For these collections, new titles added by JSTOR will not automatically be activated in your profile. If you subscribe to additional titles from these collections you must individually activate all new titles.

Linking Effectively with Summon

Linking from Summon to the full text provided by JSTOR is via direct links from URLs provided to Summon by JSTOR. Summon direct linking utilizes information present in the Summon index to deep link directly to the full text of the article or book chapter, rather than passing through an OpenURL link resolver.

Libraries can control the priority of direct linking by provider within the Summon Administration Console Resource Link Prioritization section. See the Resource Link Prioritization section of the Summon: Administration Console: Settings article in the ProQuest Support Center.

If you are using a link resolver other than 360 Link from ProQuest, you will need to activate your JSTOR collections in your ProQuest Client Center profile <u>and</u> in the activation tool provided by your link resolver provider.

Review Summon configuration options and search features

Direct links and prioritization of these links

Direct links in Summon are links that are provided by the content provider, and these are used to link directly to a particular item rather than going through your link resolver. This linking method is considered more accurate and efficient than OpenURL linking.

Direct links from items in Summon can originate with items that are designated as being provided by JSTOR, or from record(s) with which they have been merged.

Record de-duplication
 Summon merges duplicate records that match on core fields such as title, author, date, volume, and issue. Only one result is shown in the list of brief results.

- * Public Library Collections
 - Collection I includes all <u>Arts & Sciences collections</u> and the <u>Business</u> IV Collection.
 - Collection II includes all archival Life Sciences content on JSTOR (including the Life Sciences Collection and the Ecology & Botany II Collection).
 - Collection III includes all primary source collections on JSTOR: Global Plants, Struggles for Freedom in Southern Africa, African Cultural Heritage Sites and Landscapes, and 19th-Century British Pamphlets.
- ** Early Journal Content is not actually a JSTOR collection. In 2011, JSTOR made journal content published prior to 1923 in the United States, and prior to 1870 elsewhere, freely available to anyone, anywhere in the world. See http://about.istor.org/service/early-journal-content-0.
- ***Discipline packages of Current Scholarship titles
 - In 2011-2013, JSTOR sold collections of Current Scholarship titles aligned to the Arts & Sciences I through XII Archive Collections. JSTOR no longer offers these collections. Discovery partners may retain these as targets if this helps their customers.
 - JSTOR continues to offer Current Scholarship titles grouped by discipline.

By taking advantage of Summon's Database Recommendation and Best Bets tools, you can make these collections discoverable in Summon even though they aren't yet available for indexing by ProQuest.

*****The Sustainability Collections Sets are not comprised of books with publication dates from a given year or given set of years. For example, Sustainability I might have a book with a publication date of 2005. For all other collections (except Sustainability 2), all the books in the set have the publications year or years that are in the name of the set.

******This is not the name of an actual collection, just a convenient target for libraries who mass order Books at JSTOR.

- 1) There is no product called "JSTOR Complete", but some providers add it as a target for the convenience of librarians. We recommend that it not be used, since there is no simple way to define what products would be covered by this label.
- 2) JSTOR also offers several information services for individuals, which can be seen at http://about.jstor.org/individuals. None of these offerings should appear in partners' linking and discovery services.
